San Antonio Company, Lake Truck Lines, Strikes Big Win as Fastest Growing Company in the 25 MM Category by The Association of Corporate Growth – Central Texas Chapter Annual Awards Program.

Austin, Texas ... The Association of Corporate Growth - Central Texas Chapter in Austin, Texas, announced the winners of the 2013 ACG Outstanding Growth & Emerging Company Awards. Lake Truck Line's humble beginnings were rooted in Houston, Texas, formed in 1949 by Doug's father, Joe P. Cain. The decision was made to relocate the company to San Antonio in the summer of 2011. Having arrived in San Antonio with 12 trucks, the company now operates close to 100, and is projected to continue to grow. Cain attributed the company's growth to its relocation to San Antonio. He said, "I owe so much, no I owe everything to this greatest little city in the world. Moving the company to San Antonio fundamentally changed how I look at the company and how I look at living my life. I am dedicated to spending the balance of my life in loving, giving and enriching this wonderful place I am blessed to call home."

Lake Truck Lines transports oilfield materials to the well site, while Lake Oilfield Services sells and services the equipment used to contain and process those materials. All of Lake's trucks are connected to the NEX Traq Fleet Tracking System so that customers are always one click away from the real time status of their delivery and all of the equipment manufactured is engineered with long-term solutions in mind.
